- Non-Slip Flooring in Wet Areas
- Lockout/Tagout Procedures in Place
- Use of Ergonomic Tools
- Safety Signage Displayed Clearly
- Proper Waste Management Procedures
- Secure Storage for Valuable Equipment
- Noise Control Measures in Place
- Vibration Control Measures in Place
- Eye Protection Measures Adopted
- Regular Breaks for Tasks That Demand Concentration
- Safe Lifting Techniques Practiced
- Regular Tool Maintenance Scheduled
- Electrical Safety Verified
