

Children's Clothing Shop Risk Assessment Checklist

- Non-toxic materials used in clothing.
- Child-safe displays and racks.
- Adequate fire safety measures.
- Clearly marked emergency exits.
- Visible size charts for all clothing ranges.
- Child-friendly fitting rooms.
- Secure payment systems in place.
- Regular cleaning of the store.
- Accessible and updated First Aid kit.
- Clear product labels indicating material and care instructions.
- Effective anti-theft measures.
- Regular staff training on child safety.
- CCTV coverage in key areas for security.
- Clear return and exchange policy.
- Good ventilation especially in fitting areas.
- Spacious aisles to accommodate prams and pushchairs.
- Dedicated customer service desk for queries and feedback.
- Hygiene standards for try-on clothing.
- Supervised play area for children (if available).
- Regular stock checks for product quality.
- Feedback system for customers to report safety concerns.
- Child-friendly signage for directions.
- Adequate seating for parents and guardians.
- No loose wires or hazards on the shop floor.
- Ergonomic design to prevent strains and injuries.
- Multiple payment options for convenience.
- Clean and accessible restroom facilities.
- Storage facilities for personal items during shopping.
- Information on loyalty programs and member benefits.
