

Risk Assessment Checklist for Domestic Appliance Repair Shops

- ☐ First aid kit available and checked regularly
- ☐ Clearly marked and unblocked fire exits
- ☐ Availability of personal protective equipment (PPE)
- ☐ Adequate ventilation in repair areas
- ☐ Regular maintenance of repair tools
- ☐ Staff trained on safety procedures
- ☐ Electrical equipment regularly inspected
- ☐ Rapid cleanup of any spills
- ☐ Staff trained on products they repair
- ☐ Safe storage of hazardous materials
- ☐ CCTV in place for security
- ☐ Clear customer safety guidelines posted
- ☐ Fire safety measures in place
- ☐ Good hygiene practices maintained
- ☐ Data protection measures implemented
- ☐ Tools securely stored when not in use
- ☐ Clear pathways with no trip hazards
- ☐ Safety precautions for any machinery
- ☐ Safe lifting techniques trained and practiced
- ☐ Secure payment methods in place
- ☐ Safety measures for handling chemicals
- ☐ Proper waste disposal procedures
- ☐ Staff trained for emergencies
- ☐ Ergonomically designed workspaces
- ☐ Appliances securely stored pending repair/pickup
- ☐ Maintenance of an incident log
- ☐ Clear info for customers on repair timelines
- ☐ Anti-theft measures in place
- ☐ Noise control measures in workshop areas
