

Electronics Store Safety Checklist

- Adequate fire safety measures in place
- All electronics properly grounded
- No trailing wires on the floor
- CCTV cameras operational
- Shelves securely anchored
- Adequate lighting in all areas
- Regular equipment safety checks
- First aid kit available and stocked
- All staff trained in emergency procedures
- Proper signage for all potential hazards
- Secure storage for hazardous materials
- Ventilation systems functioning
- No obstructions in emergency exit paths
- Spill kits available in case of chemical leaks
- Proper storage for heavy items
- All staff trained on manual lifting techniques
- All display screens at eye level
- Anti-slip flooring installed where needed
- Regular pest control checks
- Safe storage for flammable materials
- Regular electrical equipment inspections
- Isolated areas for battery charging
- Safety barriers in place where needed
- Staff trained in basic first aid
- Regularly updated risk assessments
- Safe disposal procedures for electronics

- Clear policy on handling customer data
- Staff briefed on potential in-store theft risks
- Proper storage for compressed gas cylinders
- Secure areas for cash handling
