## Risk Assessment Checklist for Picture Framing Shops

- $\square$ All sharp tools stored safely and out of reach
- $\quad$ Chemicals for preservation are safely stored
- $\square$ First aid kit is available and fully stocked
- $\square$ Adequate ventilation in areas using solvents
- $\square$ Fire extinguishers are present and checked regularly
- $\square$ Procedures in place for safe glass handling
- $\square$ Workstations are ergonomically designed
- $\square$ All electrical equipment regularly inspected
- $\square$ Floor is free of slip and trip hazards
- $\square$ Emergency exits clearly marked and unblocked
- $\square$ Safe procedures for using ladders or steps
- $\square$ Safe lifting practices in place for heavy frames
- $\quad$ Displays are securely fixed to prevent toppling
- $\square$ Safe disposal methods for broken or waste glass
- $\square$ Adequate lighting in all work areas
- $\square$ Staff training on all equipment and safety procedures
- $\square$ Personal protective equipment available and used
- $\square$ Machinery like mount cutters used safely
- $\square$ Storage areas organised to prevent falling items
- $\square$ Customer areas free from hazards and obstructions
- $\quad$ CCTV systems functional for security
- $\square$ Cash handling procedures are secure
- $\square$ Fire safety protocols established and known by staff
- $\square$ Regular waste disposal, especially for hazardous materials
- $\square$ Security systems in place and functional
- $\square$ Customer data protected and GDPR compliant
- $\square$ Cleanliness and hygiene standards maintained
- $\square$ Regular maintenance checks on equipment
- $\square$ Safe procedures for deliveries and pickups
- $\square$ Emergency contact list accessible
